Name of the state animal of Tamil Nadu is Nilgiri tahr. They prefer grass-woodlands, open mountain grasslands, and mountain slopes. Nilgiri tahr is found in Western Ghats, Kerala and Tamil Nadu in southern India. Nilgiri tahr is a social animal. Their legs are strong and dark grayish brown in color, the inner parts of legs are paler or dirty white in color. Females have two nipples. Females and immature males are an overall yellowish-brown to grey with the underparts being paler. Males are larger than females and of darker color when mature. The face of female is the same color as the body and has no distinctive markings. In mature males, the face is nearly black and strikingly marked. Eyes of Nilgiri tahr is brownish black in color, a fawn-colored ring encircles the eye, with a similarly-colored patch behind each eye. The age of sexual maturity is between 24 to 36 months. During courtship, males will wet themselves in their own urine and even decorate their horns with mud and grasses. Females usually give birth to a single young. Their gestation period is between 6 to 7 months. For the first few weeks of life the infant lies hidden while the mother forages, but by two months of age the kid follows its mother.

Anaimalai Tiger Reserve, earlier known as Indira Gandhi Wildlife Sanctuary and National Park (IGWLS&NP). Anaimalai Wildlife Sanctuary, is a protected area located in the Anaimalai Hills of Pollachi and Valparai taluks of Coimbatore District and Udumalaipettai taluk in Tiruppur District, Tamil Nadu, India. According to the National Tiger Conservation Authority, the Reserve presently includes an area of 958.59 km2. The park is named after former Prime Minister of India Indira Gandhi who visited the park on 7 October 1961. The main tourist facilities are located in the northeast corner of the park at "Topslip", so named because of the local 19th century practice of sliding timber logs down the hills from here. Animals of least concern here include: golden jackal, leopard cat, jungle cat, spotted deer, barking deer, mouse deer, wild boar, common langur, bonnet macaque, Asian palm civet, small Indian civet, Indian gray mongoose, striped-necked mongoose, ruddy mongoose, grey slender loris, Indian giant squirrel, Indian crested porcupine, Indian pangolin, Indian porcupine and three-striped palm squirrel. Over 250 species of birds have been identified in the park. It is home to 15 of 16 species of birds endemic to the Western Ghats.
