1. The question paper consists of 50 MCQ's for TGT level in different subjects carrying one mark each.
2. The question paper consists of 100 MCQ's for PRT's carrying one mark each. The question paper will consist of General Awareness, Computers, English, Hindi, Science, Mathematics and Reasoning.

Note for TGT candidates: Out of 50 MCQ's, 5 MCQ's will be based on computer application to check the computer proficiency.

4. **Time Duration**
