**GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS**

1. The question paper consists of 50 MCQ's for TGT level in science subjects carrying one mark each.
2. The question paper consists of 100 MCQ's for PRT's carrying one mark each. The question paper will consist of General Awareness, Computers, English, Hindi, Science, Mathematics and Reasoning.
3. The question paper consists of 30 MCQ's for Receptionist carrying one mark each and 20 marks for Practical.

**Note for TGT candidates:** Out of 50 MCQ's, 5 MCQ's will be based on computer application to check the computer proficiency.

PRT	All subjects of primary level	Basic knowledge of different subjects upto graduation and computer literacy.
RECEPTIONIST	General and Computer	General Awareness and Computer Literacy

5. **Time Duration**

TGT	One hour except for TGT Mathematics (Two Hours)	09:30 AM
PRT	Two Hours	11:00 AM
RECEPTIONIST	One Hour for MCQ Test	09:30 AM

6. Use of mobile phones, calculators, and all other electronic devices are not allowed in the examination hall.
7. Candidates will not be allowed to leave the exam hall before the exam is over.
8. There will be no negative marking.
9. 50 % score would be considered pass, however if no candidate qualifies for particular post then merit will be reduced by 10%.

**Note:**

1. The list of subjects for the screening test and date of written test along with schedule would be uploaded shortly.
2. No written test for
  - a. Candidates who have cleared Online Screening Test conducted by AWES and have scored 50% marks in Part A for PRT's and 50% marks in Part A and Part B for TGT Posts or have appeared for OST on
  - b. Candidates who have cleared CTET/TET with 60% marks for the post applied.
3. Posts where total applicants are 10 or less than 10, no screening test would be conducted.
